Mountain Tour - \$150.00 per person

Approx. 2+ hours

Join an experienced ranch hand on one of our Open-Air Vehicles and take in breathtaking views of mountain elevations up to 6,000 feet above sea level. Expect sightings of ranch animals as well as native wildlife. Stop at cultural and historical monuments like Carrizal Springs, See Native American rock art and abandoned rock houses and ruins which were once part of Shafter Ghost Town.

ATV Guided Rides – \$150.00 per person

Approx. 1.5 hours

Cibolo Creek Ranch has numerous trails, all accessible by one-seat ATV or four-seat Viking and each lead to unique areas. Apart from the rugged terrain with spectacular views, be prepared to see birds and wildlife. Minimum age requirement of 16 and a driver's license. Min 2 people. Max 5 people.

Horseback Riding - \$175.00 per person

Approx. 1.5 hour

No matter your level of riding experience, you are sure to enjoy this true Texas Ranch experience.

Minimum age 8 years. (If the child is younger and has experience the wrangler may make an exception upon request). Occasionally we can add riders if someone has cancelled; please check with the office.

Please be aware that we do not allow the horse to run or canter; our terrain will not allow us to do so. Boots are strongly suggested. For your safety, no tennis shoes or sandals are permitted for horseback riding.

Minimum 12 hours advance notice required to book Horseback rides. Scheduled at 10:00am or 2:00pm

Ranch Tours- \$150.00 per person Approx. 3.0 Hrs.

We will take you on a company vehicle through all our 3 historic properties; Cibolo Fortin, La Cienega Hacienda and Fort and La Marita spread throughout the Cibolo Ranch Resort 30,000 acres.

Milton Faver (c. 1822–1889) was a pioneering cattle rancher in Presidio County, Texas, the preeminent cattle baron of the Big Bend in the nineteenth century, and one of the most important individual contributors to Big Bend history. Also known in his time by the honorary title, don Melitón, he founded Cibolo Creek Ranch halfway between Marfa and Presidio, Texas in 1857.

Faver built the first of his three adobe forts, El Fortín del Cibolo, in 1857, as a defensive measure against Apache, Comanches, and bandits of all kinds. Faver later built El Fortín de la Ciénega ^[6] (the Fort at the Marsh), where he headquartered his cattle operation, and El Fortín de la Morita^[7] (the Fort at the Little Mulberry Tree), which became the center of his sheep and goat operations. His vast enterprise not only supplied beef but also farm produce and his famous peach brandy to cavalry troops at Fort Davis, settlers in the region, and after silver was discovered, to the miners in Shafter,^[8] next door.

Trap Shooting - \$175.00 per person Duration 1.5 hour.

Enjoy hitting fast-moving clay disc targets (clay pigeons) launched from the High House using a shotgun. Learn how to position your body, mount the gun to the correct hold point, and lead a moving target. Guns and clays provided. Listed pricing includes two boxes of shotgun shells. Additional boxes to be charged according to quantity and caliber used. Min 2 people. Max 8 people.

12 Station Sporting Clay - \$190.00 per person

Compared to skeet, sporting clays offers the wider variety of hunting-style shots. This makes it great way to sharpen your skills for the season or to keep them sharp all year.
